he peaceful existence of Reykjavik is rocked when two sisters (seven and ten) are found brutally murdered. The two detectives Edda Davíðsdóttir and Jóhannes Scram are determined to solve the puzzle by any means necessary, and as they begin to uncover the

disturbing details of the case they come to realise that they have the worst case in the history of the city on their hands. One of the main suspects is the bewildered brother of the lead detective Edda, who is newly released from prison and trying to rebuild his life. But when

the fingers start to point at him his life faces another turn. All these stories are combined into a thrilling novelistic mosaic tale that echoes societies fear and the uncertainty of not knowing.



"When I was younger, a child was killed in my hometown in Iceland and I remember thinking "what about the victim's mother?" That question stayed with me for many years and when I started writing Cruelty I decided to blend that story with other stories I had heard from people and out came this personal but yet so distant story." 



remote Finnish village in Lapland, just across the Swedish border. A retiring police officer learns that his illegitimate son Jaakko has been released from prison and is terrorizing the area. Jaakko has discovered a big family secret and seeks for revenge by assaulting people dear to his father - including his fathers biological son. The hatred between the two brothers leaves the area in a state of vengeance and violence forcing the villagers to take the law in their own hands. While trying to prevent the brothers from killing each other, the police officer is forced to face the mistakes he has made in the past.



"I wanted to make film about a father trying to fix his past mistakes by helping his two sons. Lasse Kuntonen is a retiring policeman in a remote village in Finnish Lapland. Lasse has a dark, violent history and a distant relationship with his two sons. I was interested in telling a story which sets in outbacks where people are used to look out for themselves, and at the same time explore a difficult father and son relationship."



Jussi Hiltunen is an awarded filmmaker from northern Finland. Hiltunen graduated from Kemi-Tornio University of Applied Sciences in 2011. His short film All Hallow's Week was selected for Berlinale 2012 and won several awards in international festivals. Law of the Land is his debut feature film.





-year-old runaway Tia hitches a ride on an isolated country road. When the car crashes with fatal consequences, Tia finds she has nowhere to go. Seeking out the family of the crash victim, Tia moves onto the farm of fellow survivor Will and his pregnant wife Donna. When Donna's bereaved six-year-old niece Lily also comes to stay, Tia finds a purpose in helping the girl come to terms with her father's death. But as Tia's bonds with Will and Lily deepen, her presence threatens the family's delicate balance.

"My story takes place in that topsy-turvy time after a tragedy when people, desperate to connect, are reaching out blindly or withdrawing completely. I wanted to explore the relationship between mothers and daughters. What happens to a mother when she's incapable of mothering? What happens to a daughter when she's scared of losing her mother's she's scared of losing her mother's love? I wanted to tell a story about feeling directionless and not knowing how to take the next step. But what I most hope to express through this film is the great capacity we have as human beings for love, kindness and forgiveness."

Director Jackie van Beek



Jackie is a New Zealand actor, writer and director. She has made seven short films that have played in festivals including London, Palm Springs and MIFF. Her short film, Go the Dogs, played at the Berlinale in 2011. Jackie won SPADA New Filmmaker of the Year in 2013 (NZ) and was awarded first prize in the 2015 WIFT International Showcase for her short film Uphill. As an actor she is best known for her role in the vampire comedy, What We Do in the Shadows. The Inland Road is her debut feature.





We are introduced to the world of the Oddsockeaters through a small but brave hero called Hugo. The life of his grandpa

Lamor, who raised him, is nearing its end and Hugo must overcome his fears, leave their apartment and seek out his uncle Big Boss and two crazy cousins. He draws his courage from what his grandpa taught him – love toward family, good manners and the Oddsockeaters' ten commandments, and stick to it in his new home with Big Boss,

even when he often gets into tight scrapes by doing so.

Set against the backdrop of a gangster story involving two feuding gangs of oddsockeaters, Oddsockeaters is a heartwarmingly comical story of a small oddsockeater in a big world.

WHILE WE LIVE

Inspired by true events, "While We Live" follows four people in Northern Denmark and how their fates intertwine in a tragic accident. When Kristian travels to his hometown Gribskov to visit his stepdad, who has fallen terminally ill, he learns that everyone still blames him for a tragic accident that tore the family apart, five years earlier. Emotions and conflicts resurface as Kristian faces his exgirlfriend and their child in a final attempt to, by his stepfathers dying request, reunite the family.

"The inspiration from this film comes from over a decade ago when friends of mine were in a tragic moped accident that cost a teenager his life. I saw how the dark cloud transformed an entire community. Looking back, it was an equally transformative experience for me. The result is a movie that deals more with life and death rather than traffic accidents."

Mehdi Avaz is a 34-year-old Iranian born first-time director and a prizewinning still photographer. He spent the last two years developing the vision of While We Live, together with his brother, 28-yearold Milad Avaz - a former corporate strategist and first time feature film writer and producer. "Tve always been fascinated by the ideas of destiny and fate. The concept behind RABBIT was to introduce a horrific 'event' and explore a genetic link between identical twins and their ability to communicate telepathically. I was interested in exploring how two characters, sharing 99 percent of the same DNA, deal with such feelings of loss, pain and guilt. What if they could communicate such feelings to each other? On the surface this notion appeared to be quite fantastical, but as I continued my research I discovered this to be not only feasible, but for many a very real phenomenon."


Director Sine Skibsholt


