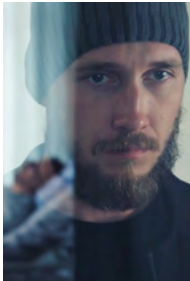

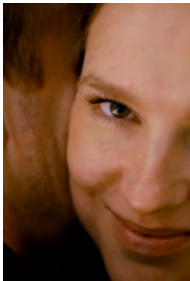

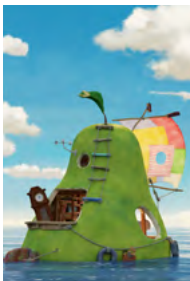

"I've always been fascinated by the ideas of destiny and fate. The concept behind Rabbit was to introduce a horrific 'event' and explore a genetic link between identical twins and their ability to communicate telepathically. I was interested in exploring how two characters, sharing 99 percent of the same DNA, deal with such feelings of loss, pain and guilt. What if they could communicate such feelings to each other? On the surface this notion appeared to be quite fantastical, but as I continued my research I discovered this to be not only feasible, but for many a very real phenomenon."

Luke Shanahan is one of Australia's most exciting young writer/directors. Possessing a truly original body of work, he is best known for his use of long shots and twisted take on sibling rivalries. At film school graduation, he was hand picked by Michele Bennett to join other dazzling film voices at Cherub Pictures. There he worked alongside acclaimed directors Andrew Dominick, (Chopper, Jesse James), John Curran, (Stone, The Pained Veil), Nash Edgerton, (The Square) and Justin Kurzel (Snowtown, Macbeth).



“The inspiration for this film comes from over a decade ago when friends of ours were in a tragic moped accident that cost a teenager his life. We saw how the dark cloud transformed an entire community. Looking back, it was an equally transformative experience for us. WHILE WE LIVE

Inspired by true events, “While We Live” follows four people in Northern Denmark and how their fates intertwine in a tragic accident. When Kristian travels to his hometown Gribskov to visit his stepdad, who has fallen terminally ill, he learns that everyone still blames him for a tragic accident that tore the family apart five years earlier. Emotions and conflicts resurface as Kristian faces his ex-girlfriend and their child in a final attempt to, by his stepfather’s dying request, reunite the family.



Mehdi Avaz is a 34-year-old Iranian born first-time director and prizewinning still photographer. He spent the last two years developing the vision of While We Live together with his brother, 28-year-old Milad Avaz, a former corporate strategist and first time feature film writer and producer. The film is based on the Avaz Brothers’ own experiences while growing up in a Danish suburb.

ODDSOCKEATERS

Oddsockeaters are small invisible creatures responsible for socks that go missing when we only have one left from a pair – the odd sock. They eat socks, but only one from each pair.

We are introduced to the world of the oddsockeaters through a small but brave hero

called Hugo. The life of his grandpa Lamor, who raised him, is nearing its end and Hugo must overcome his fears, leave their apartment and seek out his uncle Big Boss and two crazy cousins. He draws his courage from what his grandpa taught him – love towards family, good manners and the oddsockeaters’ ten commandments, and stick to it

in his new home with Big Boss, even when he often gets into tight scrapes by doing so.

Set against the backdrop of a gangster story involving two feuding gangs of oddsockeaters, Oddsockeaters is a warm-hearted comical story of a small oddsockeater in a big world.

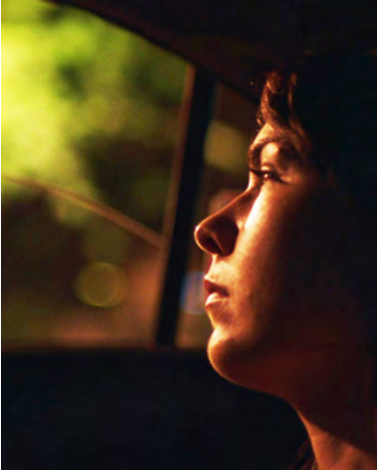

ELLIPSIS

In the middle of a crowded city the paths of two strangers, a man and a woman, collide. This accidental chance occurrence sets in motion a chain of events that sees the two strangers embark on a night of adventure and connection that challenges their separate lives. Ellipsis is a film about the random nature of life and human interaction. Set in Sydney over the course of one night, it is also a portrait of the city and its inhabitants. The film celebrates the distinct nature and idiosyncrasies of the people that live and work there.



“Ellipsis was devised as an experiment. Conceived in 3 days, shot in 7 days. The idea was propelled out of my experiences working as an actor over 30 years in film, the objective was twofold - to observe the effect on actors performance when all artifice is stripped bare and to trial a fast paced, efficient shooting regime allowing actors to instantly and organically engage in any real situation as the minimal crew captured the drama.

Focusing on small moments of honest human connection, filmed largely in my lively, eclectic inner city Sydney neighbourhood and featuring real life characters interacting with the 2 main actors, Ellipsis is the result of this experiment.”

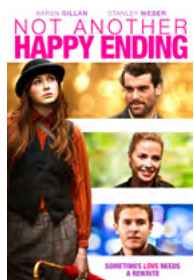

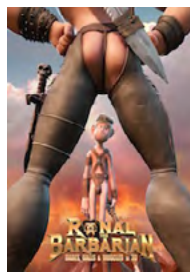

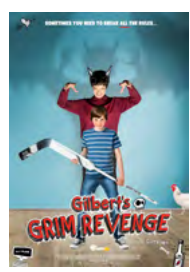
